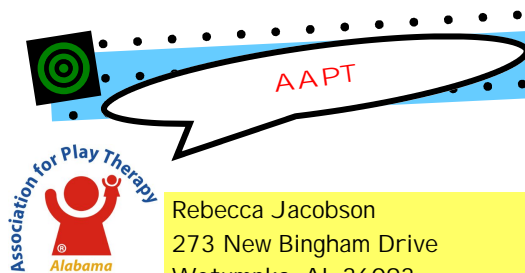

Using Play Therapy Techniques with Families

The basics of Filial Therapy will be presented including the history and variations of Filial Therapy as well as practical applications through various techniques. Filial Play Therapy can be seen as a manualized therapy fitting the current model of Evidence Based Practice. The theoretical model for filial therapy will also be presented focusing on the unique aspect of FT of parents serving as the primary change agents for bringing about positive changes in their children's development; it is getting parents to play with the children in a genuinely therapeutic way following the Child-Centered Play Therapy principles. The research base of the therapy will be reviewed. The work of Guernsey, Landreth, Glazer, and VanFleet among others will be presented. Originally applied with typical child behavior and/or emotional problems this method has now been applied successfully to a variety of treatment issues including divorced, blended, foster, adoptive families and even parent surrogates. The goals, activities and the process of filial therapy will be described and discussed supported by case examples. Participants will be provided with the resources needed to develop a **personal** filial play therapy manual.

1. Explore Filial Play Therapy and why it is useful.
2. Demonstrate Filial Play Therapy techniques through illustration and video.
3. Examine the history of filial play therapy and the Theoretical Model.
4. Explore the goals and applications of filial therapy.
5. Create a personal filial play therapy manual.
